## 3 Release Functions

#### 3.1 Main Functions

BlueSoleil 6.4 or above version is required.

The release provides:

	Auto connect to preferred device
	Record historical connected device
	Delete connected device history
Wireless VoIP Call	Quick dial to a specified contact via Bluetooth headset
	Answer an incoming call via Bluetooth headset
	Hang up a call via Bluetooth headset
	Chat via Bluetooth headset

#### 3.2 Installation

Before installation:

- 1. Uninstall the earlier version of BlueSoleil VoIP on your computer.
- 2. Access Control Panel from Start menu, and then choose Uninstall a program. Select BlueSoleil VoIP in the program list and remove it.
- 3. Bluetooth adapter can be remained plugged or unplugged during installation.
- 4. Users must log on as the administrator to install BlueSoleil VoIP.
- 5. BlueSoleil VoIP can also be removed from BlueSoleil Plug-Ins manager.

Installation steps:

- o Double-click setup.exe to start installation.
- o Follow the instructions of install wizard.

Note: With regard to the installation command line, please refer to setup.ini in the installation folder for detailed instructions.



#### 3.3 Extra Functionality

- "Mute on/off" function. Easily switch voice between Bluetooth headset and PC during VoIP chatting.
- "Suspend/Resume" function.
- Serial Number license supported.

#### 3.4 Functional Restrictions

Major functional restrictions apply to this release:

- Only Skype is supported in this version.
- Three way calling is not supported.

• Update to support BlueSoleil 8.x version.

• Fixed bug: The audio devices sometimes may not be switched correctly when run BlueSoleil VoIP on Vista OS for the first time after the installation.
